

NEW Exhibition Rules
VIRTUAL Coachella Valley Watercolor Society (CVWS) Show 2021

Mission Statement:	To promote the creative talents and art appreciation of its members and to stimulate art interest and support art education for the young people in the Coachella Valley.
General:	In order to enter CVWS shows, members must have paid their dues/renewals prior to December 31 st of the current fiscal year.
Allowed:	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Original art created in the last two years• Art shown at a meeting or 'Painter of the Month'
Not Allowed:	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Matted or framed art• Art created in a class or workshop• Art that is a copy or a study of another artist's work (including commercial photography). this is because of copyright laws• Any art that is not original to the artist• Art previously exhibited in any CVWS judged show• Art that is damaged, inappropriate for public display i.e. nudity or does not meet entry requirements
Size:	Any size is acceptable
Mediums:	Artwork must be water-media painted in a primarily aqueous manner. Non water-based media may be integrated but cover no more than 20% of the artwork. No oils, water- miscible oils, encaustics, or photography.
Prices:	\$125 Minimum
Presentation:	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Images for entry must be submitted unmatted and unframed• Artwork may be presented on watercolor paper, paper-based board, watercolor canvas, Yupo or other synthetic paper• Paintings may be on wrapped canvas or "cradled" painting panels with a minimum depth of 1 1/2". The sides of wrapped canvases must be staple free. Canvas boards, including clayboard, aquaboard, gesso board or canvases less than 1 1/2" deep are acceptable. All canvases must be protected with a layer of medium, acrylic varnish or paint, including sides
